

Adams County 4-H Clover Cash Program



What is Clover Cash? How does it work?

Clover Cash can be used for members to attend Colorado 4-H Leadership Camps (CLC, LDC, Youth Fest and Colorado State 4-H Conference.)

Members can earn money beginning January 1, 2016. Money earned can be accrued and kept for members to participate in future conferences. Members will only be able to carry over a maximum of \$250 in their account.

In order to have any accrued money carried over for future attendance, members must attain a sponsor or donation for one of the County Council Fundraisers (Boots and BBQ Bash or Run 4 the H 5K).

Members must volunteer at the Run 4 the H 5K or Boots and BBQ Bash in order to have access to their Clover Cash funds. If they do not volunteer at one of the events, their funds will be released back into the County Council fund at the end of the financial year.

Members will have a form that must be initialed by a 4-H staff member or Council Advisors in order to earn their Clover Cash for attendance at events outside of meetings(volunteers opportunities). Parents hours will also be kept track on members Clover Cash Forms.

The first conference that members will be eligible to use Clover Cash for will be the State 4-H Conference in June of 2016.



Accumulation of Funds for Members:

- Members will earn 20% on the cash donations that they secure for the County Council Fundraisers.
- Members will earn 20% on the sale of any silent or live auction items (club baskets are excluded).
- County Council Meeting Attendance: \$5/meeting
- Committee Meeting Attendance(Council Representative): \$10 (one time per year)
- County Council Officer: \$10 (one time per year)
- District Senator/Officer: \$10 (one time per year)
- State Officer: \$50 (one time per year)
- Volunteering at a Council Sponsored Event(Boots and BBQ Bash, Run for the H 5K, Ag Day, Cloverbud Camp, Easter Egg Hunt etc. non fundraising): \$25 for a full day event, \$15 for a half day event

Accumulation of Funds for Immediate Relatives:

- Parents, guardians and immediate relatives of members can also earn Clover Cash.
- Up to two volunteers per member per event will be eligible to earn cash for their 4-H member. They must designate AT THE EVENT who should benefit from their Clover Cash earnings.
- Clover Cash can only be earned by volunteering at County Council events and fundraisers.
- Clover Cash amounts for volunteer positions will be specified on the volunteer registrations forms, which will be available online. Amounts will vary.
