Anyone who is 12 years of age or younger on January 1, 2017 enters only as a Junior in Knitting (Department 930) and Crocheting (Department 940). All others enter as Adults.

Entry Process:

1. Where you will attach entry tags to all pre-entered items. Bring pre-entered items to the **Parks & Extension Building, 1st floor**, on Friday, July 28th, 2017 from 4:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.
2. No props are allowed due to space limitations.

Judging: *We welcome anyone to watch the judging, as space allows.*

1. Judges reserve the right to move entries from one department or DIVISION to another to assure the best possible judging environment for all exhibitors.
2. All other Departments begin at 9:30 a.m., Saturday, July 29, 2017.

Entry Fee \$4.00 Per Item

RULES:

1. Quilts are defined as having three layers: a top, a batting and a backing.
2. Quilts must be quilted through all of the above three layers: top, batting and backing.
3. Only one entry will be accepted in each class per exhibitor
4. Articles can be entered in the Adams County Fair only once.
5. Please cover name labels attached to quilts.
6. Articles should be clean and free of odors and pet hair.
7. All quilts must be completely finished.
8. For those exhibitors who are entering any quilted item for judging for the first time, write "FIRST TIME ENTRY" ON THE ENTRY TAG. This will make you eligible to compete for the Colorado Quilting Council award and ribbon for *First Time Competition Entry*.
9. **Items can only be entered in Adams County Fair one time.**

1. Decorative items (placemats, table runners, pillow or sham, purse or tote)
2. Quilted wearable (jackets, vests)

DIVISION: JUNIORS

NOTE: In this Department, Junior refers to anyone 18 years of age or younger at time of entry.
