DIVISION: OPEN BUCKET CALF CONTEST

Friday, August 4, 2017, 9:30am

RULES:

1. Calves must be born between April 1 and June 1, of the current fair year.
2. Exhibitor will be allowed to show only one calf.
3. Bucket calf judging will be on child's ability to handle the calf.
4. All calves must be on the bucket, bottle, or weaned at fair time (no nurse cows!)
5. All calves must be halter broken.
6. Calves may be of any breed or sex.
7. All calves will be released immediately after the show.
8. Fair rules and regulations on stalls, care of livestock, and health are to be adhered to.
9. Winner will receive ribbons only.

4. All horses must be vet checked. Horses will be available for participants use.
5. If participant wants to bring their own horse, the horse must go through vet check: July 29th 3-6PM or July 30th 6:30-7:30AM. in lieu of attending the scheduled health checks, a health certification issued within 10 days of arrival must be presented to the show office.
6. Helmets are **REQUIRED**.

1. Everyone must pre-enter to participate
2. Entries will be open to anyone (ages 5 to 7 years) who has an interest in the sheep or wool industry, i.e. raising sheep or sewing with wool.
3. You do not have to own your own sheep to participate in this contest. However, if you are being sponsored, you must designate your sponsor in your resume.
4. Outfit – contestants will model outfits made of at least 50% wool. The outfit does not have to be handmade. It should be appropriate for the age and present a stylish, attractive picture showing the beauty of wool. If you constructed your outfit, you will receive one extra bonus point.
5. Three judges will award points for the sheep (general appearance, fitting, leading ability, etc.), the contestant (general appearance, selection and fit of outfit, presently, etc.) and overall effect (control of the sheep, total look, etc.). The contestant awarded the highest number of total points shall be declared the winner. In case of a tie, bonus points will be awarded for originality.
6. All entrants must turn in a resume to the clerk at scales at weigh-in, Thursday, August 3, 2017, from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. Resume will include name, age, club name, school, sheep background, sponsor (if any) and description of the outfit.
