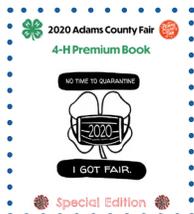


Tabletop and Gloverbud Project Checklist

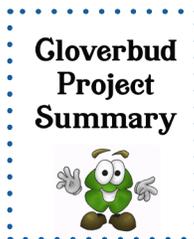
PROJECT DROP OFF - SUNDAY, AUGUST 2

- Sign up for a time to drop off projects! Each family will sign up for a time to drop off all of their projects. <https://10to8.com/book/kl1bqoyjbocdexmkqq/>
- Projects will be dropped off on the North Side of the Waymire Dome Building at the Fairgrounds. (see attached map) Please stay in your car until you have pulled up under the overhang and one of the check in tables is open to take your projects.
- ALL projects must be labeled **before** dropping off the projects. Please have the labels on the projects **PRIOR** to coming to the fairgrounds. Labels should include:
 - Name
 - 4-H Age (as of December 31, 2019)
 - 4-H Club
- Please have your project and record book together.
 - **Clothing/Artistic Clothing Projects** - please have your project on a hanger and in a clear plastic garment bag. Put your record book in a grocery sack or in a gallon sized bag and place the bag over the hanger
 - **Cake Decorating** - please bring your cake in a cake carrier, that is labeled with your name. This will help to protect your cake.
- Remember - you must have a record book with each project that you enter (exception to this are the large and small animal posters and small animal photos)
- Because there are no in-person interviews, each project entered should include the 2020 Interview Judging Form. This form will be placed inside your record book for each project entered.
