### **RULES:**

1. Cloverbud setup and display will be in the Al Lesser Building.
2. All exhibitors must be enrolled in the Adams County 4-H Cloverbud program. CLOVERBUD 4-H IS STRICTLY NON-COMPETITIVE.
3. All exhibits will receive a ribbon and will be displayed for the duration of the Fair. Only one exhibit per member per project area will be accepted, however, an exhibit may consist of one to six articles made by the Cloverbud 4-H'er.
4. All projects must be labeled with name and club of exhibitor.
5. Each 4-H club is responsible for setting up their own display of exhibits for the fair. Each club should make their own club sign or poster with name of club to accompany the exhibit. Maximum size of poster is 22" x 30" and minimum size 8 ½" x 11".
6. We will try to have a backdrop for each club, but due to space this may not always be possible. Call the Extension office to reserve table space for your club exhibit by Friday, July 21, 2017. Due to space restrictions, please limit the items displayed. ***Each club is limited to two tables.*** We will do our best to accommodate requests made after Friday, July 21, 2017, but clubs will be limited to what is available.
7. Each club leader is responsible for placing ribbons on projects. Ribbons will be supplied by the Superintendent.
8. Enter all 4-H Cloverbud projects and displays, except live animals, in the Al Lesser Building, Monday, July 31, 2017, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Please call the office if you have a conflict during this time to make other arrangements. Please coordinate with your club Cloverbud leader/parents to find a time to set up the Cloverbud projects.
9. ***Release - All Cloverbud 4-H projects, except live small animals, will be released Monday, August 7, 2017, between 4pm and 6pm. Please do not ask to remove the exhibit prior Monday.***

### **4-H Cloverbud Exhibits may consist of the following areas:**

#### **Needlework projects:**

- Cloth
- Clothing
- Embroidery
- Sewing
- Weaving
- Macramé
- Fabric decoration
- Knitting and Crocheting

#### **Arts and Crafts projects:**

- Painting and sketching including watercolors, finger paints, chalk, pencil, pen, crayon on wood, metal, paper, canvas and various kinds of folk painting.
- Sculpting – any article constructed from wood, clay, paper mache, wax, metal, etc.
- Jewelry
- Doll craft and puppets
- Decoupage
- Woodworking – drawing on wood, building toys, etc.
- Holiday and seasonal decorations
- Creative do-it-yourself articles made from scrap of anything items made from a kit

#### **Music and Dance project area consists of:**

- Homemade musical instruments



- Evidence of dancing activity such as poster, pictures, photos, etc.

### **Sports and Recreation projects:**

- Homemade sports equipment such as games, jump ropes, bows and arrows, etc.
- Evidence of sports and recreation activity such as posters, pictures, photos, etc.

### **Nature and Environment projects:**

- Pine cones
- Pressed leaves and flowers
- Dried flower or weed
- Homemade bird feeders
- Pictures or poster about nature
- Insects
- Anything done on wood other than decoupage (with dried flowers, leaves, etc.)

### **Gardening projects:**

- Vegetables
- Terrariums
- Flowers
- Plants

### **Science projects:**

- Science experiment
- Plaster lid sundial
- Chemistry
- Poster or pictures about science

### **Personal Development projects:**

- Scrapbook or poster of accomplishments

### **Food projects:**

- Any poster about food or food prepared by the 4-H Cloverbud member that DOES NOT REQUIRE REFRIGERATION or a scrapbook about nutrition.

### **Self-Determined projects:**

- Any project completed by 4-H Cloverbud member that does not fit into the other categories.
- Lets Learn About Goats – Completed workbook and/or poster or scrapbook
- Lets Learn About Horses – Completed workbook and/or poster or scrapbook
- Lets Learn About Rabbits – Completed workbook and/or poster or scrapbook
- Lets Learn About Dogs – Completed workbook and/or poster or scrapbook
