Tree Information

- Once you bring your trees home, please put them somewhere cool and dark. Keep them moist.
- Trees like to be planted at the same level as the soil, so that their first root is at the soil surface. If planted too deep, you can cause the tree to rot.
- Trees should be watered the day that they are planted. It is best to regularly water them the first year, so that they can establish well. Trees with higher water needs such as the Colorado Blue Spruce, Lindens, Willows and the Cottonwoods may require lifetime watering.
- A drip system is easy to set up and provides the most efficient method of watering.
